Whereas the Settler is desirous of establishing a trust for public charitable objects.

And whereas they Trustees have at the request of the setter, agreed to act as the first trustees of these present as testified their being parties to and executing these present.

And whereas it is necessary to declare the aims and objects of the public charitable public Trust being constituted under these presents.

### **NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-**

That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the trustees, a sum of Rs. 1,00,001/- (One Lakh One) (hereinafter called the trust Fund which expression shall-include cash and any other property of investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part there of might be converted invested or varied from time to time which may be acquired by the trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents ) and the trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

That the name of the trust shall be SURYAMATI

EDUCATIONAL TRUST office will be situated Add.-Vill.+P.O-Bhabua, Ward No.-19 Distt.- Kaimur, Bihar 821101 and/or at such other place or places as the trustees may decide from time to time.

### 2. THAT THE OBJECT FOR WHICH THIS TRUST IS ESTABLISHED

ARE

(A) To organise, promote, undertake all programmes for the foundation of fearless and non-succumbing society on the basis of truthfullness & non-violence.

(B) To organise, promote, undertake, sponsor, carry-out, all programmes for the benefit of—naturally-challenged—person, schedule caste, schedule tribes, people under poverty line, old-aged, widow, and down trodden irrespective of caste, creed, sex and religion such as

## IN THE FIELD OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT

- a) To establish, develop, maintain school, colleges, libraries, universities, laboratories, skill development centers, competition, preparation centers, yoga and spiritual centers, sports training centers, vocational training centers, research and other institutions or the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge among the public in general.
- b) To establish maintain and run engineering college, pharmacy college, dental college, Para medical college, polytechnic college, B. E.J. College, Polytechnit College, Nursing College, I.T.I. (NCVT), Amant Training Institute & others
- award programme and render other kind of aid to students including supply of study materials, books, stipend, medals and other incentives.
- d) To organize programme for the promotions of preprimaryeducation, non-formal education, computer and information technologies, leadership development, educational, infrastructure research and envelopment, socio-scientific research, management,

(a) To carry out all the programmes / projects for the awakening of national integration, communal harmony, cooperation, and cooperative behaviour attitude development moral and social

habit development in the youth and to ensure participation in the development of nation and humanity.

(b) To organize and install infrastructure for the promotion of sports, yog, meditation among & organize cultural programme, music, dance programme and training center or the field of art and culture.

### IN THE FIELD OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE :

- a) To undertake, establish, assist, organize or conduct the programme of research, management and infrastructure development in the field-of health-and-family welfare.
- b) To establish, organise, run or maintain Hospital, Nursing Home, Care and Care Centres, Medical education and research centre in state -of- the- art.
- c) To undertake, organize, establish or run the medical education centre, college and research centre.

## IV. IN THE FIELD OF AGRICULTURE AND ALLIED INDUSTRIES DEVELOPMENT: -

- a) To conduct awareness and exposition programme of appropriate and low cost technologies agriculture.
- b) To conduct intensive research in the field .- of fisheries, aquaculture, poultry, dairying, sheep & goat, horticulture, floriculture, aromatic medicinal plants, fruits. hybrid vegetables, mushroom etc. and land the benefit of research.
- c) To make the market-mechanism most favourable to the farmers. To develop the infrastructure for the easy and safe delivery of agro-products. Also establish and run financial Institution for the benefit of agriculture and allied industries-related people.

### V. IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENT & FOREST: -

a) To undertake a!! programmes for ensuring social accountability in conservation, preservation and control to the environment, forest, wild-life.

b) To organise and run special sanitation and environment protection programmes for Hospital, Fair, Melas, places of Pilgrimage 'Railway stations, Bus stands, Canteens, Hotels, Industrial ergonomics.

### VI. IN THE FIELD OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT: -

- a) To promote education, training and research programmes in Rural Management and generate a Human Resource Force to settle the needs of people in rural areas.
- b) To organise, conduct, sponsor, the intensive programme Rural housing. Rural finance. Marketing, all type of Micro Credit Finance for poor man women mechanism development. infrastructure Cottage small scale industries development, operative and cooperation, Integrated wasteland Development, Technology Development Extension and training programme Investment-Promotion Schemes for the promotion of rural infrastructure. watershed unutilised and water management and resource development welfare; programme, and strengthening programme for marginal and promotion underprivileged farmers, of cost effective including rural technologies, sanitation low-cost latrines.

## VII IN THE FIELD OF SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGIES AND COMMUNICATION & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES

- a) To carryout all the programmes science and Technology and communication Information Technology for popularization, use and inculcation of scientific temper among the people Also ensure the use of technologies in the field of rural development appropriate technology, rural technologies, environment and ecology, non conventional energy, formal education, computer education.
- All the activities shall be Non Profitable and shall be done on No.

  Profit No Loss basis.

- 4. All the incomes, earnings, movable / immovable properties of the Trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its Aims and objects only as set for in the deed of the Trust and no profit there of shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends-bonus, profits or in any-manner-whatsoever to the present or the past member of the Trust or to any person claiming through any one more of the present or the past members. No members of the Trust shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the Trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of his membership.
- 5. That the Trust fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund also by donations and other contribution from time to time.
- 6. That the Trust Fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in para-3 herein above unless the other objects added to the trust objectives.
- 7. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the Trust.
- 8. Subject to the provisions of Income Tex Act. 1961 as amended from time to time, the Trustees will keep the Trust Fund of such portion there of as they may in their absolute discretion, think fit and proper, without being answerable or accountable to the beneficiaries or any other property for any loss invested in such shares, stock, securities and debentures of acquisition or construction of any immovable property in India, of free hold or lease hold tenure, and may deposit the amounts with any scheduled Bank, Company or Private firm any Individual on such terms and conditions as they think fit in the matter of investment of Trust funds, the provisions of section 20 of the Indian Trust Act shall apply, in the event of Trustees purchasing any immovable property or properties or advancing moneys or mortgage,

they shall be entitled to accept such title or evidence of title as they shall think fit in their absolute and un controlled discretion. The Trustees shall have power, if any deed in their absolute discretion to sell the Trust Fund or any part-there of any such immovable property purchased by them under the power aforesaid and any other shares, securities, etc and stand possessed of the money to arise from such sale upon after paying there out the expenses pertaining to such sale upon the Trusts and with the subject to powers and provision including and all the posers contained by and under these presents declared and contained concerning the Trust Fund which or the proceeds thereof, shall have laid out in purchase of property or properties as have laid out in purchase of property or properties as aforesaid or such of them as shall be then subsisting and capable of taking effect.

- That for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, the Trustees shall have the following powers. :-
- (i) To accept any donation, contribution Loan Grant or subscription in cash or in kind, from any person (s) or association of person(s) or body corporate or Trust with on without conditions.
- (ii) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust, or the Trust fund of accumulations there to any one or more or the objects of the Trust, as the trustees may in their discretion, dream fit from time to time.
- (iii) To sell, dispose of alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.
- (iv) To open account in the name of the Trust, with a band or bank to operate such account and to give instructions to the Bank and to provide for opening the operation of such account by one or more of the Trustees or by an agent appointed by the Trustees.

- (v) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound refers to arbitration, all actions, suits claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust fund.
- (vi) To engage or make provision for the engagement of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or settler cum presidents or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration f the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to engage or provide for the engagement.
  - (vii) To make very alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs there of and / or running any institutions in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the object of the trust.
  - (viii) To start, abolish, discontutions and restart any charity of charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
  - (ix) To set apart and / or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust-Fund or the part there of for any of the objects of the Trust.
  - (x) To join, to operate or amalgamate this Trust with other of others having kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the Trustees may in their discretion think-fit-particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this trust.

- (xi) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or otherwise to different charitable institutions, societies organizations or Trust in India which may have been established or which may hereinafter be established of the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institutions, societies, organization or Trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
- (xii) To settle all accounts and to compromise, abandon, or refer too arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (xiii) To borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustee to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- (xiv) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban local municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, glits, subscription, affiliation and other assistance including lease and substance of property with a view to promote the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to put to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments including taking land on lease may be made.
- (xv) To take over or amalgamate with any other Charitable Public Trust, Trust, association, or institution with similar objects.
- (xvi) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institutions or institutions having objects either wholly or or in part similarly to the

- objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
- (xvii) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies institutions or associations with which this Trust in authorized to amalgamate.
- (xviii) To take land / property on lease and then after sublease the land / property to the farmers and other organizations like cooperative / society / urban public bodies, / gram panchayat or any being thereof in rural area / local municipal / district and other bodies corporation / company for farming / agriculture / plantation purposes.
- These Trustees shall be accountable only for such money, and funds, which will actually come into their hands
- 11. The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration but they

  Trustee may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by
  them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.
- 12. The Settler cum President for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and reappointment the trustees for the time being consider proper.

#### 13. A PERSON SHALL CEASE TO BE A TRUSTEE EITHER

- If he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meeting of the Trustees or for one calendar year whichever is longer or
- If he is requested to resign by 2/3 rd or as near thereto as possible of the remaining trustees.
- In the absence of Settler the Trustee of the Trust's will take charge and function of Settler

 Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

The Trustees may from time to time frame rules of the conduct and regulations of the meetings of Trustees. In the absence of such regulations.

- (a) Five Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.
- (b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustee.
- (c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the
  Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced
  in writing under the hands of two thirds of the trustees
  shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly
  passed at a meeting of Trustees.
- (d) Act means: Indian Trust Act -1882
- 15. The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing constrained shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these present.
- The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31<sup>st</sup> March every year.
- 17. The Trust and the Trust funds shall be irrevocable for all the times.
- 18. It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a Charitable purpose in law, and all provisions thereof shall be construed accordingly.

- Two thirds majority shall continue the office of the Trust at unless changed by the Trustees.

# 21. POWER & FUNCTION OF THE OFFICE BEARER. SETTLER PRESIDENT

  - (g) If shall be his duty to see that the resolution at the respective meeting are implemented and give to effect to timely.
  - (h) He/She will produce the expenditure of the trust before the Committee for approval.
  - (i) He/She will submit annual progress reports and audited statement of accounts of the Trust before the general body meeting.
  - (j) He/She will guide direct and supervise all the activities of the Trust .
  - (k) He/She shall place the financial position of the Trust in every meeting of the governing body.
  - (I) He/She will receive grants, funds, donations and subscriptions on behalf of the Trust

### . 22- INSPECTION OF REGISTERS :

All registers will be kept in the registered office. Any member may inspect these registers with the prior permission of the Settler President

### 23. AMENDMENTS:

Any additions, alterations, or omission in the objects and Rules and Regulations of the society shall be effected by resolution of the Trust

by 3/5th member of the General body at a special general body meeting of the society.

24 **LEGAL PROCEEDING**:

The Trust may sue or be sued in the name of the Settler President.
